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Mandate Debate

Vaccination ends pandemics. The governor of Washington just issued a vaccine mandate for long term care workers for the "[public good](#)." California, Massachusetts and Connecticut are mandating the vaccine for nursing home workers. With the delta variant causing sharp spikes in infections in unvaccinated regions, the federal Equal Employment Opportunity Commission okaying vaccine mandates, major health organizations calling for mandates, and the FDA on the verge of giving full approval to the Pfizer vaccine, it seems the tide is turning in favor of requiring long term care staff and residents get the COVID vaccine. However, some states like Florida have banned mandates. Last week, the National Association of Health Care Assistants (NAHCA) announced it is divided on the issue. "While NAHCA urges all frontline staff caring for elders to get vaccinated, the organization also recognizes the significant division on the question of vaccinations among its membership." We can't afford to let another variant take hold. Consult counsel regarding whether mandates are legal in your state. Let's do what we can to put this pandemic behind us.
